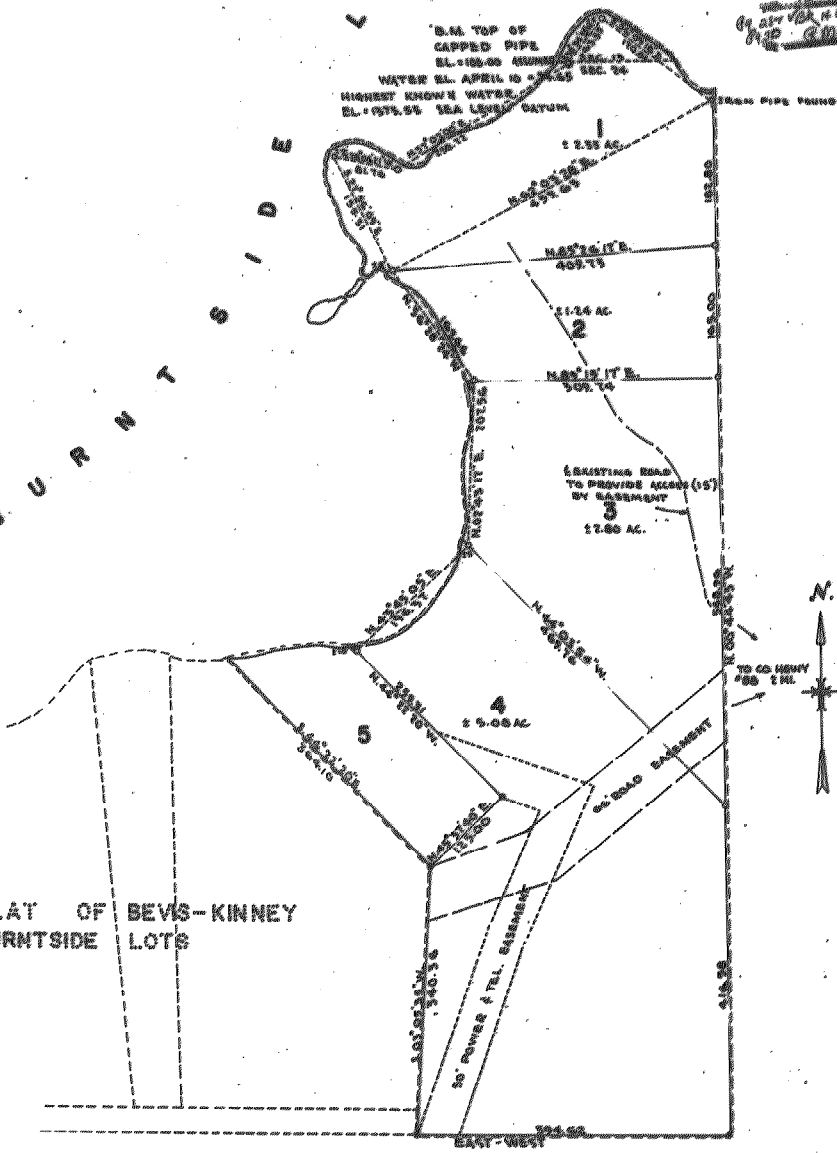

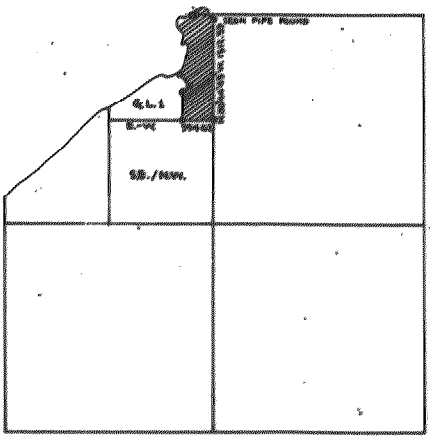


PLAT OF BEVIS-KINNEY
