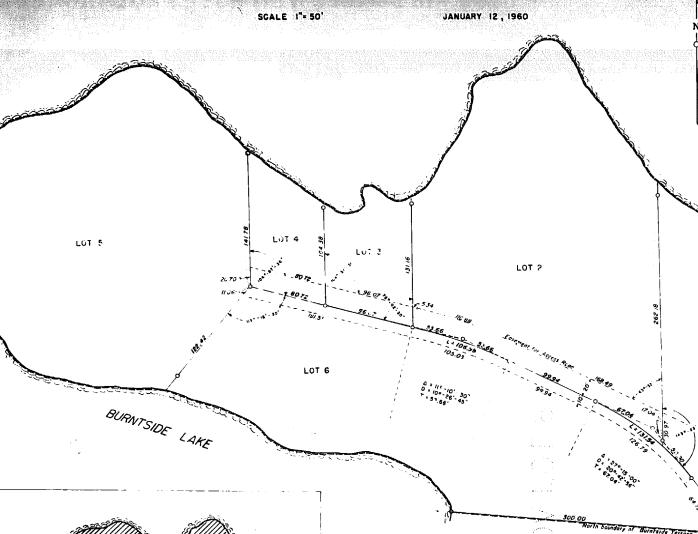
IN GOVERNMENT LOT 6 SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 63 NORTH RANGE 13 WEST
